

State engagement with NSDA ARUNACHAL PRADESH

- 30th August 2013 – NSDA in collaboration with the state of Arunachal Pradesh conducted state level job cum Skill Development at Itanagar.
- State has empaneled 33 VTPs to provide training and placements to 9,012 youths. Out of those approximately 3,000 have been placed.
- 5th August 2014 – NSDA along with Department of Labour and Employment and Government of Assam organized regional level workshops for 8 north eastern states.
- Regular follow up with the Director, Department of Skill Development and employment generation
- In March, 2017, a skill conclave was held in Arunachal Pradesh to disseminate appropriate information to prospective training providers in skill development initiative as well as to sensitize and create awareness on skill development programmes

- **Challenges faced by State**
 - Continuous follow up has been done with Arunachal Pradesh since 2015, still no concrete evidence on any progression in terms of NSQF alignment.
 - Coordination with other departments of skilling for reporting skill target and achievement, initiative is lacking
 - Delay in sharing Information on skill related activities with NSDA
 - Workshop on NSQF could not be arranged so far inspite of continuous follow up
 - No core committee formed so far
 - No information received on list of courses to be aligned to NSQF

- **Way forward**
 - NSQF workshop to be held shortly
 - Core committee to be formed
 - List of courses run in state to be share
