NSDA Interaction with the State:

NSDA has organized 2 workshops in the State for the purpose of NSQF implement, the details of which are as below.

Workshop1:

The first NSQF workshop was organized in the state of Karnataka on the 8th and 9th of September 2015. Since Karnataka is one of the project states for the India EU Skill Development Mission, the workshop was conducted along with the India EU team. The workshop focused on introducing the National Skill Qualification Framework and associated concepts to the stakeholders from the State.

Workshop 2:

Karnataka State Government is in the process of forming a new Department for Livelihood and Skills. The state had requested NSDA for support and guidance regarding how to go about this activity and what components to be incorporated under the department. Upon request from the Labour and Employment Department of the Karnataka State Government, a second workshop was organized with the stakeholders from the state on the 1st of April 2016.

During this workshop, NSDA and the India EU team presented a few existing models of SSDMs and Administrative structure existing in different parts of the country. The process of formation of the new department is under way and NSDA has been regularly following up with State for updates on the same.

During the visit in April, the NSDA team also visited the Karnataka German Technical Training Institute (KGTTI, A Govt. of Karnataka Undertaking) training center in Bangalore to understand the training model and mechanism.

Core committee yet to be formed in the state for NSQF implementation.

Way Forward:

- NSDA will work closely with the new department of Skills and Livelihood to capacity build the various stakeholders in the state towards NSQF and associated concepts.
- Creation of a core committee in the state for implementation on NSQF.
- NSDA will work the departments in the state to align the qualifications run in the state.
