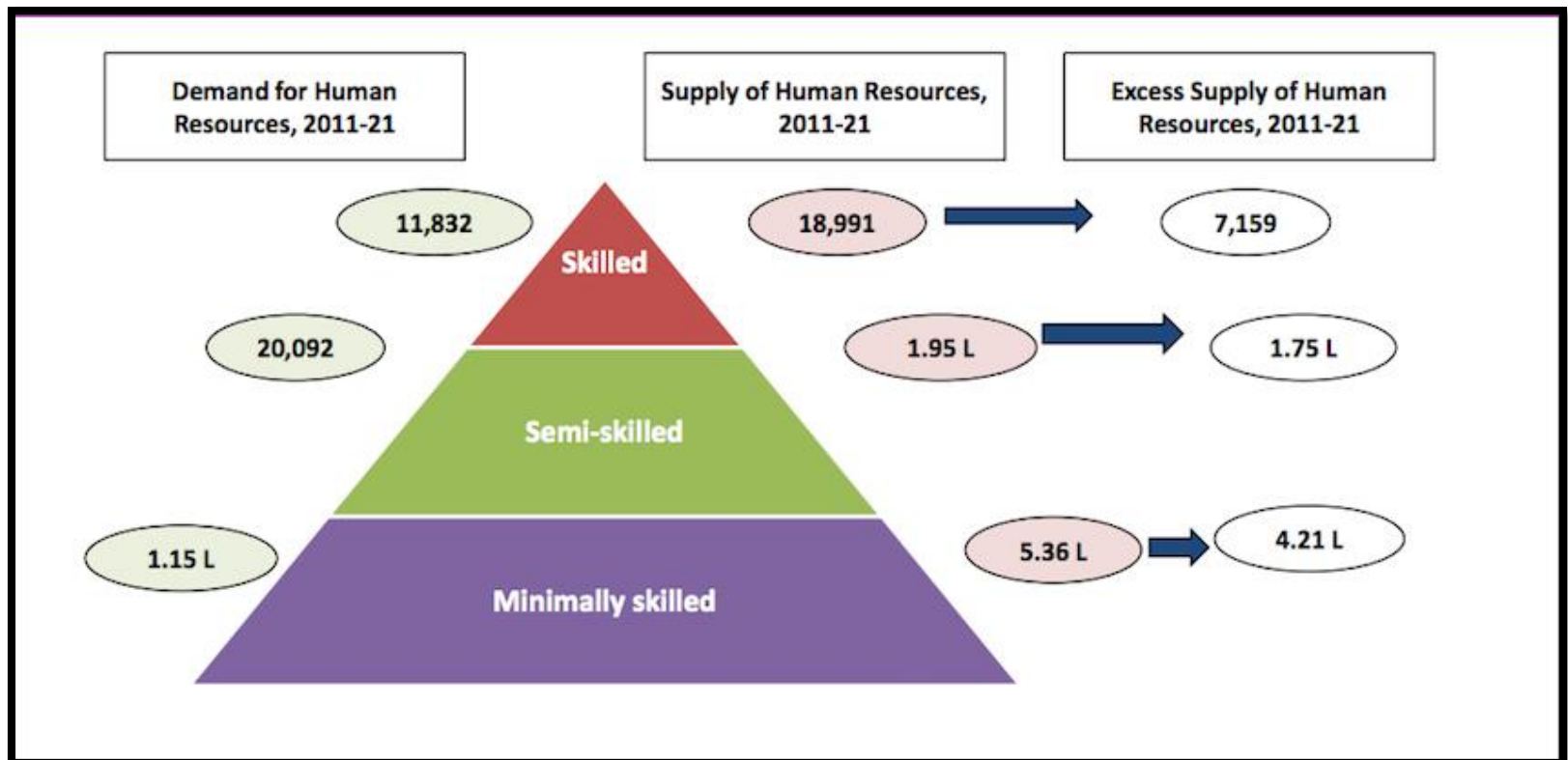

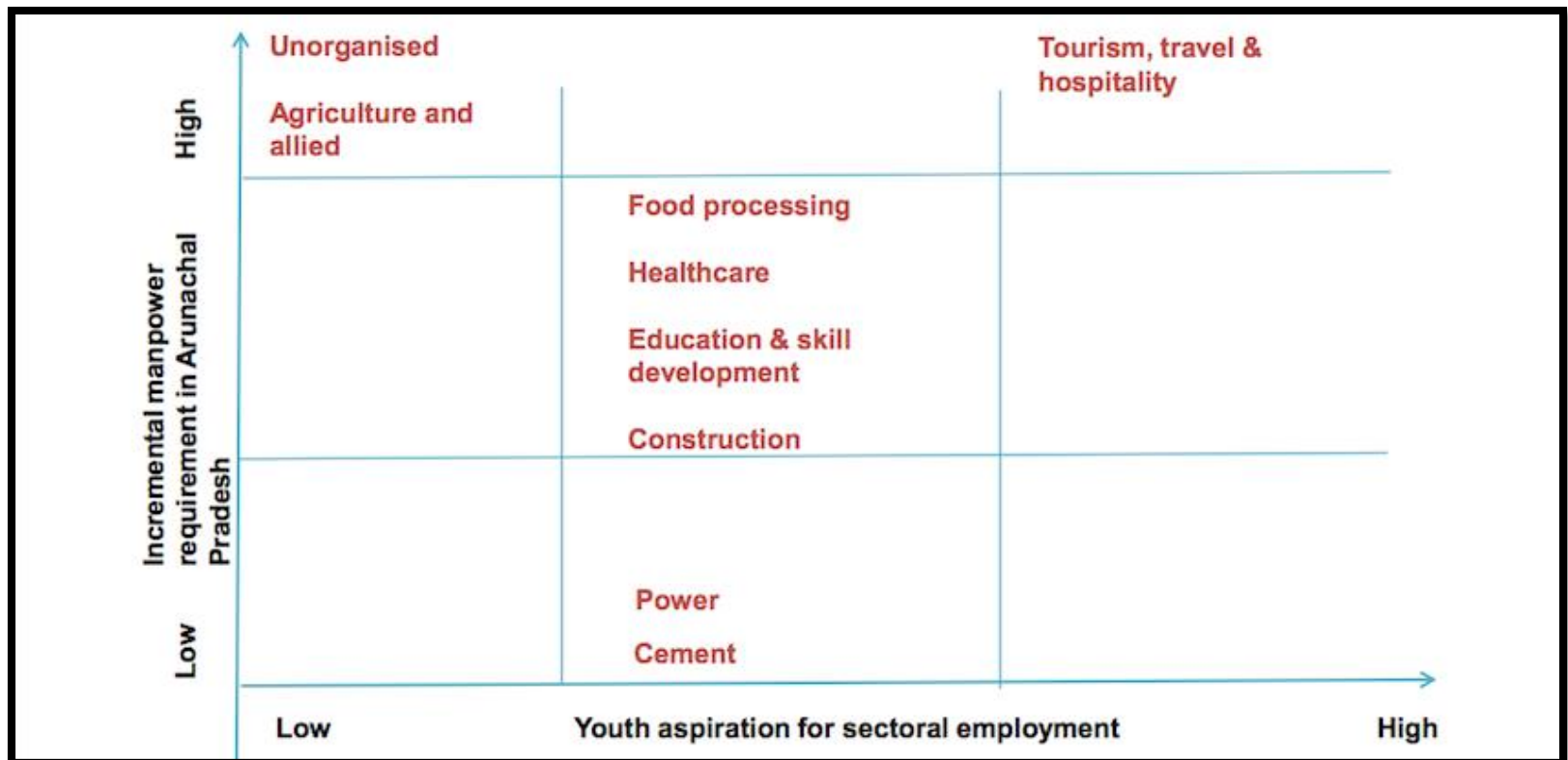
Skill Gap Analysis

State Skill Development Mission

- State Skill Development Mission:- State Skill Development Mission under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister formed on the line of National Skill Development Council.
- Arunachal Pradesh Skill Development Society:- Arunachal Pradesh Skill Development Society(APSDS) is formed and registered under Society Registration Act.
- State Steering Committee (SSC):- State Steering Committee with Secretary (Industry) as Chairman and Members from other stakeholders for monitoring the implementation of Skill Development Schemes in the State.

SSDM cont

- Nodal Department:- The Department of Industries Govt.of Arunachal Pradesh. The State set a target on the line of union govt. to produce 50,000 skilled manpower by 2022. This will be achieve through various Schemes like Craftsman Training Scheme (ITI), Skill Development Initiative (SDI) through Vocational Training Providers both Govt. and Private.
- State Project Implementing Unit:- In order to execute the policies and schemes of the State Skill Development Mission, the State Project Implementation Unit (SPIU) is functioning in the Directorate of Industries
- Registration of Private Vocational Training Providers (VTP) are being encouraged.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (SDI) (based on Modular Employable Skill)

- Skill Development Initiative (SDI) based on Modular Employable Scheme (MES) is being implementing in Arunachal Pradesh.
- All 5 Govt. ITIs are registered as Vocational Training Provider (VTP)
- Number of Course offered :- 18
- Number of Persons Trained :- 510
- Number of Persons Assessed and Certified by NCVT :- 212

Skill Development through CTS scheme

- Number of ITI in the State:-

Govt. :- 5 and Private - 1

- Total Enrollment Capacity :- 840

- Present Enrollment :- 353

- Number of Trades :- 22

Way forward

- Setting-up of 11 nos. New ITIs One each in every Districts including Women ITI.
- 100 Skill Development Centres (SDCs) one each in each CD Blocks to Impart Short - Term Employable Training.
- To Register more Private Vocational Training Provider (VTP)
- Setting up of Regional Institute of Training of Trainers (RIToT)
- Pro-active Placement Cell in every ITI.
- Modernizations of Employment Exchange.
- To identify Apprenticeship Training Provider in and outside the State.
- To assess and certify those person who acquired skill informally.
- Establishment of Entrepreneurship Development Institute (EDI) is under progress
- Short Term Employable Training Programme on being sponsored by NEC Shillong
