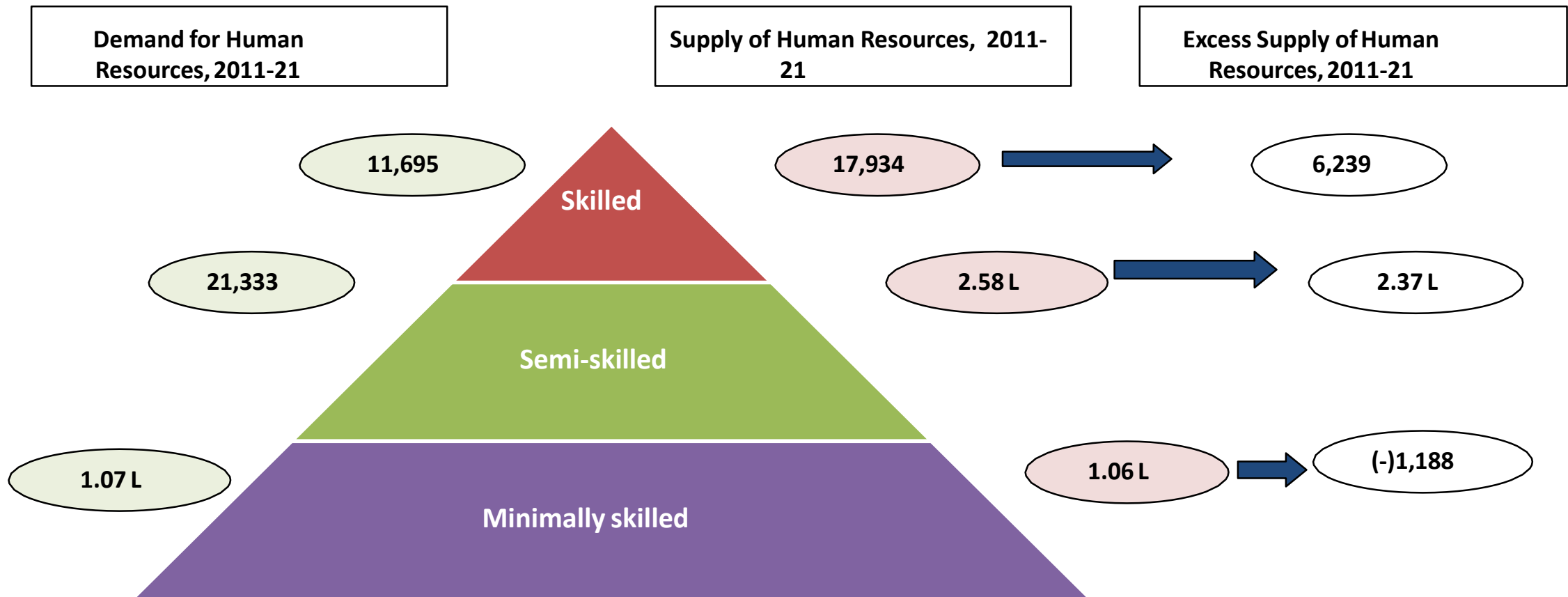

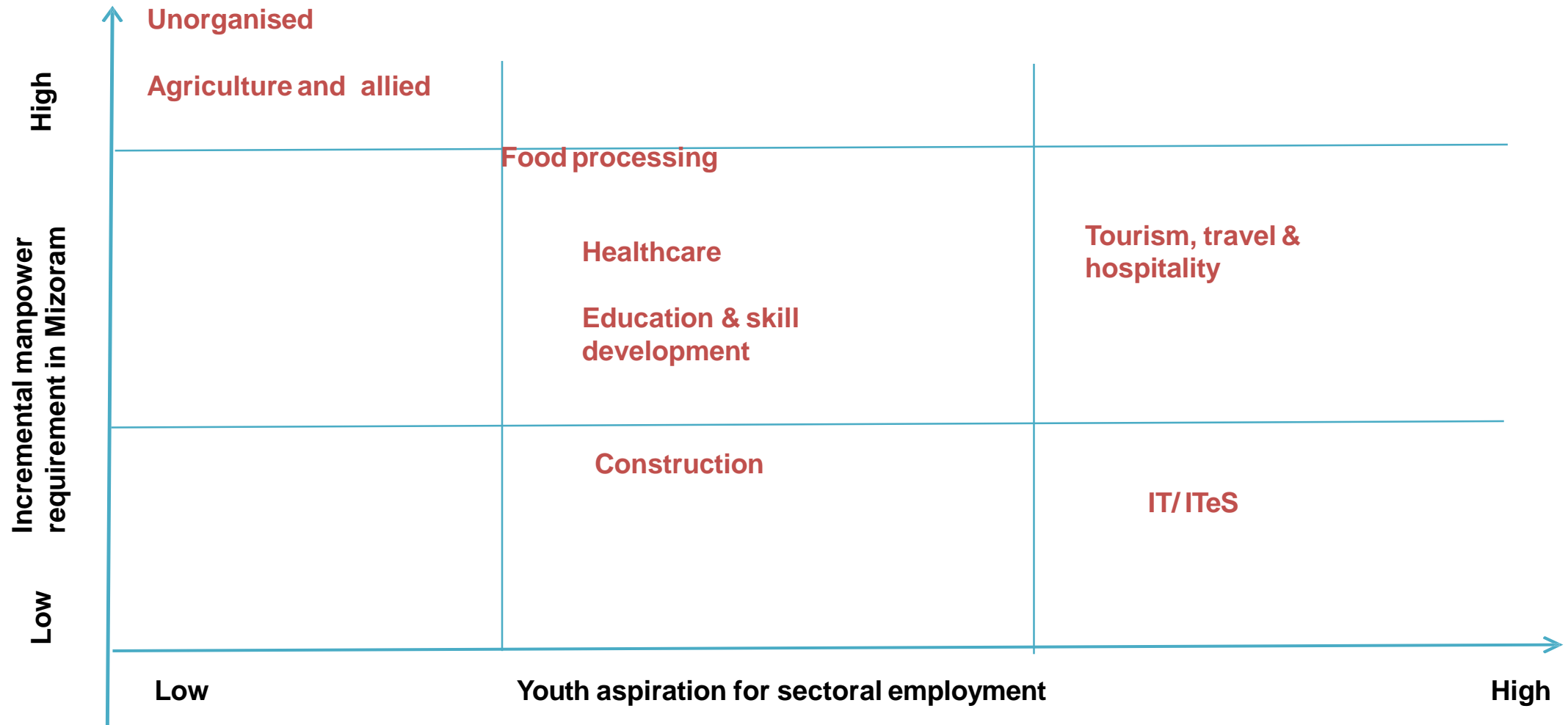

# SSDM Structure

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- The State of Mizoram has established the Mizoram Skill Development Society with the Member Secretary of the Mizoram State Planning Board as Chairman
- The State Skill Development Board has been assigned the responsibility of guiding and coordinating the various initiatives of the state in the field of Skill development. It is chaired by the Chief Secretary and the Secretary, Labour & Employment has been nominated as Member Secretary of the Board. Labour & Employment Dept. has been functioning as the Nodal Agency on Skill Development activities in the State.

  - Mizoram Skill Development Society
  - Mizoram Youth Commission.

# Skill Development Eco-System

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- Schemes : Schemes like, SDIS, Ajeevika, BADP, Schemes from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Minority Affairs & MHRD are the major Schemes being implemented by different departments in the state.
- ITI's and other other Skill centres :
  - There are 3 Govt. ITI's
  - 2 Government Polytechnics and
  - Private Skill training Centres.
