Empanelment of State-level Training Service Providers (TSPs) and Vocational Training Providers (VTPs) under the Directorate of Skill Development for imparting sector-specific trainings



Signing of MoUs with Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) for collaboration on the introduction of outcome based Trainings, assessments and certification on qualification packs (QP) and national occupational standards (NOS)

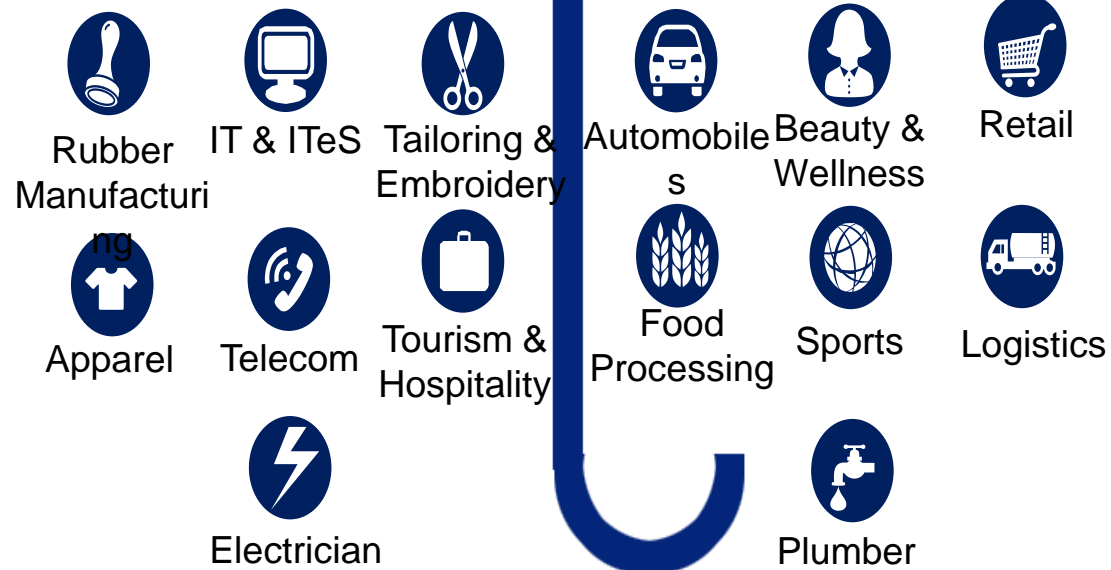

Interaction with NSDA

- The NSQF orientation workshop was conducted on 29.09.2015 with around 50 stakeholders, organized by the Mission
- The core Committee on NSQF implementation has been notified on 07.01.2016 with 14 members and the Chief Secretary as the Chairman and Director, Skill Development Mission as the Member Secretary
- A technical workshop with the core committee was held on 06.05.2016 in collaboration with NSDA.
- The state is in process of aligning its state specific qualification i.e. bamboo technology and fisheries with NSQF
- Currently the state is working with Agriculture SSC and other SSC by adopting their courses
